Mental illness affects 1 in 5 people. Individuals with mental illness can, and do, lead productive and successful lives. Often this success includes someone who has gone the extra mile to reach out, advocate, or provide an exemplary service in support of Granite Staters affected by mental illness and suicide.

NAMI NH will recognize these folks at the NAMI NH Annual Conference on April 4, 2020. **If you know of one of these special people, tell us!**

Not sure which category to choose? Just select your best guess; our volunteer Annual Awards Committee will decide which category is the best suited once they have read over all of the nominations.

Award Categories

1) Peer Support

These individuals willingly share their experiences with mental illness in support of others traveling a similar path, providing much-needed information, empathy, and hope for recovery.

2) Unsung Hero

Who's flying under the radar, not yet receiving recognition for their significant contributions? Perhaps a neighbor who has helped to create a supportive environment for a family struggling with mental illness. What about your child's guidance counselor, a local support group leader, or your primary care provider? A professor, religious leader, or mentor? A business owner or town leader? Think outside the box, and shine a light on someone doing exceptional work.

3) NAMI NH Volunteer of the Year

NAMI NH has so many wonderful volunteers helping with everything from NAMIWalks NH and organizing training materials, to teaching Family-to-Family classes and running support groups.

4) Legislator of the Year

We have 424 NH legislators and 4 US legislators. Who is advocating for mental health in our legislature?

5) Mental Health Professional

Examples include therapists, psychiatrists, administrators and case managers.

6) Educator

Do you know a stigma-stomping teacher? Who is teaching the importance of mental health for all and spreading hope to future generations? Examples include professors, teachers, or a nonacademic role such as a trainer.

7) Law Enforcement

Examples include police officers, sheriffs, probation officers, judges and attorneys.

8) Media

Examples include individuals or organizations working in all forms of media – television, print, radio or the internet, including blogs.

- The Awards Committee may choose to place your nominee in a better-suited category.
- You may nominate more than one person.
- Please complete a separate nomination form for each individual who you are nominating.
- You may nominate a person who was nominated previously but not selected.
- Contact information for both you and the nominee must be included.
- To ensure fairness to all nominees, you must limit your nomination to 250 words or fewer. (Nominations that exceed this size will be returned for editing.)
- Please only submit the written nomination; any additional materials, such as letters of support, photos, or artwork will not be forwarded to the committee.
- The number of nominations an individual receives will not affect the voting process or the outcome. Nomination “campaigns” are discouraged.
- Nominations will be chosen based on their individual content only.
