Volunteer Position Title: Reviewers Fluent in Spanish for Online Suicide Prevention Training

Location: Remote; Hours determined by volunteer

Mission: NAMI New Hampshire is a grassroots organization working to improve the lives of all people affected by mental illness and suicide through support, education, and advocacy.

Supervision: Suicide Prevention Project Manager oversees volunteers in this role.

Support and Background: Connect is a nationally recognized program that employs best and evidence-based practices to increase the competence and confidence of professionals and community members to prevent suicide across the lifespan. This course focuses on suicide prevention and intervention. Connect uses a public health approach and incorporates key elements of the National Suicide Prevention Strategy. Applying a unique holistic model and offering a community planning component, Connect stands apart from other training programs.

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NAMI New Hampshire is working to expand access to the Connect suicide prevention training series for more diverse populations including individuals whose first or preferred language is Spanish.

The Connect training program is available in multiple formats including in-person workshops and online training modules. Connect Online modules have been translated into Spanish and are ready for Spanish speakers to review before NAMI New Hampshire makes them available to a broader audience. NAMI New Hampshire wants to ensure that Spanish-speaking learners gain the same knowledge and confidence levels as demonstrated by participants who have completed the English version of the Connect Online training.

Volunteers will be provided free access the Connect Online suicide prevention training and an online survey tool that will collect feedback on each module reviewed.

Position Summary:

NAMI New Hampshire is seeking volunteers fluent in Spanish to complete the Connect Online module series and provide feedback on the quality of the translated modules through a linguistic, technical, cultural, and content review. Feedback will be provided through use of an online survey.

Volunteers offering help with this project should expect to dedicate time to the following activities.

Activity	Estimated Time to Complete
Complete Connect Online Module 1: Recognize!	1 hour
Complete Connect Online Module 2: Connect to Individuals	1 hour
Complete Connect Online Module 3	1 hour

For each module, provide feedback on the accuracy of the translation and the quality of the education by completing a project survey that will include structured questions as well as space to give unstructured feedback. This survey will be conducted in English.	20-30 minutes each = 1.0 - 1.5 hours total
Total estimated time commitment	4.0 – 4.5 hours

Desired Skills and Experience

- Fluency in both Latin American Spanish and English
- Ability to access and use a computer
- Ability to access and use the Internet
 - ❖ The training has been tested and optimized for use in Google Chrome and Firefox. It is also generally compatible with Microsoft Edge and Apple Safari. It is not recommended to attempt the course with other browsers; some of the functions may not work in Internet Explorer.

Physical demands: While performing the duties of this role, you will be required to use a computer for the length of the time required to complete the work. This may require sitting and exposing your eyesight to the blue light of the screen.

Benefits: Free suicide prevention training--after completing the Connect Online modules, the volunteer will be provided with a certificate of completion that can be used to meet employment requirements or be used for professional development.

Call to action: Be part of making important suicide prevention training accessible and available to those in the Spanish-speaking community so more people are prepared to respond effectively and compassionately to individuals in mental health crisis.

Screening process: Complete a volunteer application online and interview with the Suicide Prevention Project Manager.
