RE: NAMI NH Opposition to SB 38

Chairman Gannon and Committee Members:

Thank you for the opportunity to testify today. My name is Sam Hawkins, and I am the Public Policy Assistant at NAMI NH, the National Alliance on Mental Illness. NAMI NH is a non-profit, grassroots organization whose mission is to improve the lives of all people impacted by mental illness and suicide through support, education and advocacy. On behalf of NAMI NH, I am here today to speak in opposition to SB 38, relative to state recognition of biological sex.

As an organization committed to preventing suicide and promoting the mental wellness of all Granite Staters, NAMI NH is deeply concerned about the harmful impacts that discrimination in all forms has upon mental health. Research consistently demonstrates that experiencing discrimination has a negative effect on mental health and increases the risk of suicide. With this in mind, NAMI NH believes that stigma and discrimination, in all forms, jeopardizes mental health and wellness not just for the individual, but throughout the entire community. As such, NAMI NH is firm in its opposition to any policies that further stigma and enable discrimination.

By rolling back the discrimination protections we currently have under state law, SB 38 puts the mental health and safety of New Hampshire individuals and families at risk. With this policy in place, transgender and nonbinary Granite Staters will be exposed to discrimination - in their communities, at work, in treatment, and beyond. This would have a chilling effect on not only transgender and nonbinary people themselves, but also their families, their loved ones, and the communities they have found and formed in our state.
